

It Takes Two to Tango Ruffled Scarf



Materials

- 2 balls of Tango
- 1 set US 7 needles (a sharp point is helpful!)

5 stitches using the following method:

Insert needle into top 1/3 of the yarn and pick up a small bit of yarn (do not cast on using traditional method). To get rid of the tail immediately, simply fold the excess yarn in as you cast on.

To knit ruffle:

- Insert the needle into the first stitch as if to knit
- Instead of wrapping the yarn around the needle, pierce the yarn in the top 1/3 and draw this new loop through the stitch
- Continue knitting all the stitches on the needle, selecting approximately the same distance on the yarn to pierce about 1/2 - 1 " apart. Try to keep this space fairly consistent so the ruffles end up to be about the same size.

Knit every row in this manner until desired length. Cast off normally and weave in any ends.
